Aloha Fellow Members,

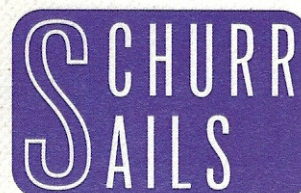

Clubhouse Search Committee Report

There are no current sales pending on the Marina Property, and as I explained last month, we have for some years been living with a 90 day eviction clause should any interest close on a sale of the Marina and request that we vacate. So nothing has changed.

But we may have found a place to buy and establish as our new PBYC clubhouse. An inspection team consisting of Rick Zern, Tom Whitehurst, Corrie Keich and the writer traveled to the shores of Lake Seminole in Georgia on Saturday September 15 to inspect a houseboat we have been considering for some time. It has 1500 square feet of conditioned indoor space and would fit our needs very well for a few years until we could buy some land. The boat would initially be docked in the Sabine Marina. There are troublesome regulatory restrictions created by the Liquor Control Board, the Dept. of Environmental Protection, the Coast Guard and the SRIA.

So I am not going to publish a complete spec. sheet with 144 photos to all members at this time because we have some way to go before this idea can become a reality. At such time as all these regulatory hurdles have been overcome, we will send all members an email with all the facts and photos and call a General Membership Meeting to discuss and vote on the purchase. For now, if you wish to do some window shopping, the boat is listed on the link below. The current asking price is \$90,000.
