Operational Procedures

Earlier this year I mentioned that your 2013 Board of Directors assembled some operational procedures. These are not by-laws. They are guidelines to help transition from one year to the next. Several of you have mentioned you would like a refresher so they appear in the following paragraphs. Hope you find this informative.

COMMODORE HANDBOOK OF OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES Current 2013

1. Budgets

Club Budget: duty of Commodore Bar Budget: Vice Commodore Fleet Budget: Fleet Captain Rear Budget: Rear Commodore

Budgets must be approved and posted (online and bulletin board) by January 1st. Prior preparation is suggested by Sept or Oct. Incoming and outgoing boards attend the December board meeting for finalization. Approved budgets may be adjusted with board approval. Expenditures over approved budgets will not be reimbursed unless the treasurer makes a decision to do so.

2. Reimbursements

Reimbursements requests need approval from the Cost-center chairperson (Commodore, Vice, Fleet, Rear) before being turned in to the treasurer.

3. Ready cash Rule of Thumb

Need \$20,000 in cash accounts January 1st to last until dues renewal. Surplus money may be deposited to the Building Fund Jan 1st at the recommendation of the treasurer and board.

4. Commodore Folder

Keep a three ring binder with by-laws, Spreader issues, minutes, P&Ls, cash flow reports, GYA schedule, Articles of Incorporation, Lease Agreement and handbook of Operational Procedures.

5. Send out Request for Agenda Items one week prior to Board and General Membership meetings.

6. Update Signature Cards

Update at January meeting. Coastal Bank and Trust Current 1/1/2013.

7. As a rule, Regattas and Events should plan to break even or better.

8. Sales tax.

When setting costs, make note that fees, dues, etc. are subject to sales tax (approx. 12%).

- 9. Secretary is to post Minutes of Board and GM meetings online when approved.
- 10. Submit all info to GYA in December as requested for their Handbook.
