the Board of Advisors



The Board of Advisors (BOA) has recently reaffirmed its support for the proposed building campaign. Not only is the plan potentially financially doable but the construction details are **achievable in the time proposed!**

But there is also a clear contingent path to certain failure that some members seem to be unaware of. It's almost too

obvious to point out, but as the deadline approaches, it needs to be a conscious reality for all 148 members: If we don't re enroll at least 100 members by July 15, we don't have the money to proceed and sustain the land and build the building. To date we have 28 renewals. It is obvious that there is no point building a clubhouse for members who have no interest in it. So in a way we are facing an existential threat with a very logical outcome: If the members are interested, we will survive. And if not, well...

This communication is not a sales pitch for being a member. Since we left the clubhouse we are all becoming aware of what its going to be like if PBYC goes away. Rather, we have written this to reemphasize the urgency of the situation and the consequences if members do not respond.

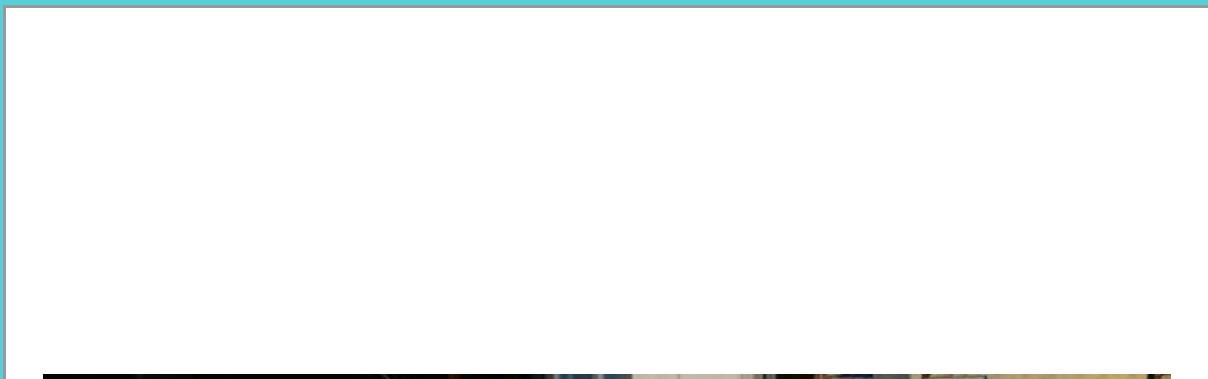
