Fleet Captain Report

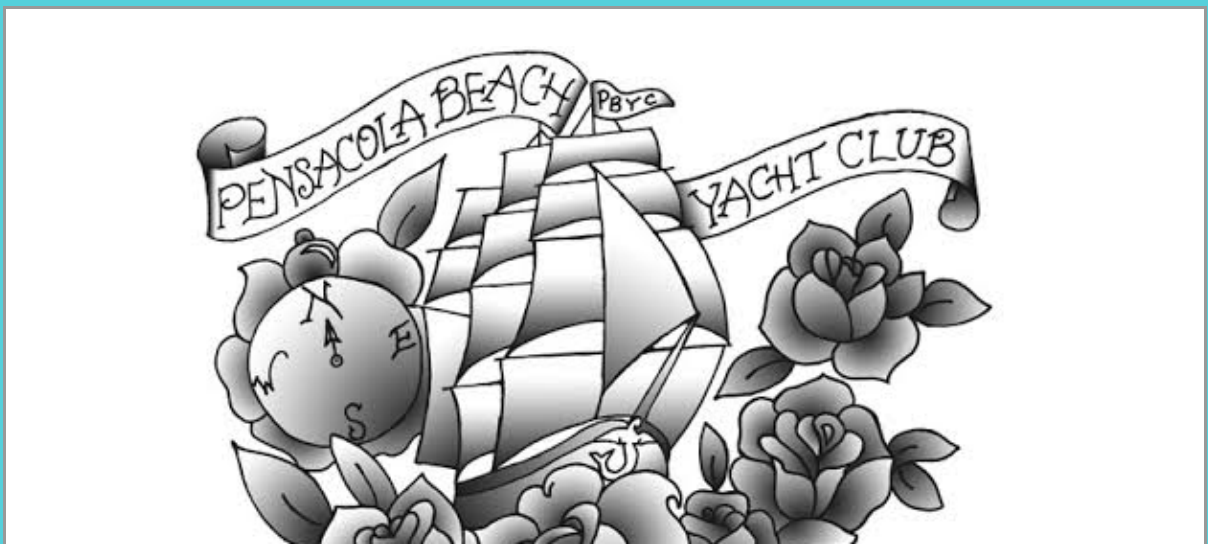
